

Media Release March 31st, 2020

Two more Chatham-Kent residents have tested positive for COVID-19.

One male, aged 45 and one female, aged 43, at the request of CK Public Health officials were already isolating at their home before the test results were obtained. CK Public Health has connected with close contacts to these individuals and they have begun their 14 day self isolation.

There are now 8 total confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Chatham-Kent, including one newly resolved.

"There should be no more guesswork when it comes to what is expected of residents, states Chatham-Kent's Medical Officer of Health, Dr. David Colby. The fate of our community, especially our most vulnerable citizens is quite literally in our hands. What you choose to do, or choose not to do matters greatly. Make the right choices."

As confirmed cases may begin to increase across the community, official news releases will no longer be sent out.
