Re: Province-Wide Shutdown - Information for Food Premises

Dear Food Service Premises Operator:

Effective Saturday, December 26 at 12:01 a.m. Ontario will enter a province-wide shutdown. The province-wide shutdown will replace the Keeping Ontario Safe and Open Framework for a period of 28 days in southern Ontario. **Food or drink establishments** must adhere to the following widescale measures and restrictions:

- Indoor and outdoor dining service is prohibited
- Takeout, drive-through and delivery services are permitted, including alcohol
- Line-ups and patrons congregating outside the establishment must be managed by the establishment; patrons must maintain physical distance of at least 2 metres and wear a mask or face covering
- Face coverings are required when entering an establishment
- Worker protections, such as personal protective equipment (PPE) including masks and eye protection, are required where persons without face coverings are within 2 metres of workers
- Nightclubs and strip clubs are only permitted to operate as a restaurant or bar (takeout, drive-through and delivery only)
