CK Public Health Offers Youth First Dose Walk-In Clinics

Chatham-Kent youth, ages 12-17, can now receive their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine by walking into the Bradley Centre without booking an appointment. Starting Wednesday, July 7th and going until Thursday, July 15, 2021, CK Public Health will be offering first doses to youth, ages 12-17, on a walk-in basis at all Bradley Centre Clinics offering the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines. Anyone aged 18+ still looking to receive their first dose will also be accommodated. Upcoming Bradley Centre Clinics offering the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine will take place:

- **Wednesday, July 7, 2021** from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- **Thursday, July 8, 2021** from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- **Saturday, July 10, 2021** from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- **Wednesday, July 14, 2021** from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- **Thursday, July 15, 2021** from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Walk-in clinics remove barriers and are very convenient, particularly for youth still needing their first dose. At this time, Pfizer-BioNTech is the only COVID-19 vaccine currently approved for the 12 to 17 age group. All appointments previously booked will be honoured.

Youth looking to receive their second dose must still book an appointment. Appointments can be booked by visiting www.getyourshotck.ca or calling 519.351.1010 and leaving a message.
