CK Public Health has been notified that there were multiple confirmed cases of COVID-19 in attendance at the Catholic Women's League dinner on Sept. 27<sup>th</sup> at the Knights of Columbus Hall in Tilbury. All attendees at this event have been fully vaccinated and therefore contacts are not required to have to isolate.

Chatham-Kent's Medical Officer of Health, Dr. David Colby advises that anyone that was in attendance at the event to self monitor for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and to get tested immediately if symptoms develop.

It is recommended that all attendees book a testing appointment for October 4th, 2021. If you have been called from the health unit as a close contact please follow the testing guidance that was provided to you.
